COVID-19 UPDATE

June 17, 2020

COVID-19 has affected how we commute, shop, work, and interact with each other. The City of Opa-locka executed a State of Emergency for the City in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. While there are no vaccines to prevent COVID-19, the Centers for Disease Control and the Florida Department of Health have issued safety guidelines to help limit spreading the virus. We ask that you continue to adhere to the safety guidelines currently in place.

On June 16, 2020 the City of Opa-locka Police Department did not receive any medical calls related to COVID-19. The Police Department issued 23 warnings to individuals for not wearing face masks at 4200 NW 135th Street, 2891 NW 135th Street, and 14566 NW 22nd Avenue. In addition, 19 warnings were given to individuals for not adhering to social distancing at 701 Opa-locka Boulevard, 2891 NW 135th Street, 15055 NW 22nd Avenue, and 13210 Alexandria Drive. One male was arrested for driving while license suspended at the 200 Block of Opa-locka Boulevard.

Direct patrol was conducted at several apartment complexes within the City.

Business checks were conducted and all were in compliance.

The COVID-19 Testing Site in the City of Opa-locka processed 153 tests on June 17, 2020.
