ORDINANCE NO. 13-27

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OPA-LOCKA,
FLORIDA, TO CREATE A COMMUNITY RELATIONS,
RECREATION AND ACTIVITIES BOARD FOR THE
CITY OF OPA-LOCKA; PROVIDING FOR
INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR
CONFLICT AND REPEALER; PROVIDING FOR
CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY;
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, the City of Opa-locka, by vote of the citizens, adopted a new Charter on November 6, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the City of Opa-locka desires to create a Community Relations, Recreation and Activities Board for the purpose of promoting, and facilitating the use of City-owned parks and recreational facilities; and to facilitate recreational activities in the Community; and

WHEREAS, the Community Relations, Recreation and Activities Board shall consist of seven (7) members, who shall be residents of the City of Opa-locka, two of whom shall be selected at-large by the City Commission. As to the remaining five members, one shall be chosen by each member of the City Commission, who shall serve a term which will coincide with that of the Commissioner who selected them. The two members chosen at-large shall each serve a two-year term. Any member may be removed at any time, with or without cause, by the Commissioner who appointed them, and in the case of the at-large member, they may be removed at any time, with or without cause, by a vote of a majority of the members of the City Commission. Members will not receive compensation for their services; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF OPA-LOCKA, FLORIDA**

Section 1. The recitals to the preamble herein are incorporated by reference.

Section 2. The City Commission of Opa-locka hereby creates an entity known as the Community Relations, Recreation and Activities Board, with responsibilities and duties as follows:

Sec. A Power and Duties

The Community Relations, Recreation and Activities Board shall be advisory to the City Commission in regard to the following matters:

1. Operation and maintenance of parks and recreation programs, facilities, and activities in the Community.
2. All matters pertaining to Community relations.
3. Special activities and programs for the benefit of the City

Sec B. Community Relations, Recreation and Activities Board shall consist of:

1. The Community Relations, Recreation and Activities Board shall consist of seven (7) members, who shall be residents of the City of Opa-locka, two of whom shall be selected at-large by the City Commission. As to the remaining five members, one shall be chosen by each member of the City Commission, who shall serve a term which will coincide with that of the Commissioner who selected them. The two members chosen at-large shall each serve a two-year term. Any member may be removed at any time, with or without cause, by the Commissioner who appointed them, and in the case of the at-large member, they may be removed at any time, with or without cause, by a vote of a majority of the members of the City Commission. Members will not receive compensation for their services.

Section 3. If any clause, section, or other part or application of this Ordinance is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or applications of this Ordinance.

Section 4. All ordinances or resolutions or parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be codified in the Code of Ordinances when the code is recodified.


Section 6. This Ordinance shall upon adoption, become effective immediately.


